IN 2010, MORE THAN 2,600 HIGH SCHOOL WRESTLERS, REPRESENTING 48 STATES COMPETED IN THE HIGH SCHOOL NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS. OF THESE 2,600 WRESTLERS, THEY SPORDED OVER 550 INDIVIDUAL STATE CHAMPIONSHIP TITLES. MORE THAN 1,400 HIGH SCHOOL COACHES WERE ON HAND, AS WELL AS 200 COLLEGE COACHES ATTENDED THE EVENT.

22ND ANNUAL NHSCA SENIOR NATIONALS, MARCH 31 - APRIL 3, 2011

The truest National Championships in any high school sport in America. The Senior Nationals has a profile and history like no other event. At the 2010 NCAA Division I National Championships, 7 of 10 Champions competed in this event their Senior year, including freshman National Champion and 2009 Senior National Champion Kyle Dake. Last year's field boasted 14-4x State Champions, 39-3x State Champions, 87-2x State Champions, and over 170-1x State Champions. You must have been a State Champion or Runner-Up during your high school career (Exceptions: CA- Top 8; IN, NJ, NY - Top 4). Other methods of qualifying include: NHSCA All American at Freshman, Sophomore, or Junior Nationals; Top 4 at the NHSCA US Open (during Freshman thru Junior year). If you have not qualified, you can petition the NHSCA for a wild card.

7TH ANNUAL NHSCA JUNIOR NATIONALS, MARCH 30 - APRIL 1, 2011

The 2010 Junior Nationals showcased extremely impressive talent with over 700 entries including 14-3x State Champions, 26-2x State Champions, and 112-1x State Champions. Overall, 417 state place winners competed to be among the nation's best juniors. There is no qualifying system for Junior Nationals. Don't miss out on your chance to be a part of this tradition.

6TH ANNUAL NHSCA SOPHOMORE NATIONALS, MARCH 30 - APRIL 1, 2011

In 2010, there were 550 entries boasting 230 State Place Winners, including 22-2x State Champions and 49-1x State Champions. The numbers and talent continue to climb each year for this event. There is no qualifying system to enter the Sophomore Nationals.

Freshmen Nationals keep gaining momentum as there are over 400 entries with 129 State Place Winners. Most exciting is the young talent making its way through the high school level, as 20 of those that participated have a State Championship under their belt. Do you want to see where you stack up? Come take your place at the NHSCA Freshman Nationals.

Top 8 place finishers for the High School Nationals (Freshman, Sophomore, Junior, and Senior divisions) are officially declared as High School All Americans. Each will receive 3 All American certificates (one for themselves, their coach, and school).
