**Boxers End December With Trips To Ashland, Las Vegas**

The Pacific men's wrestling team will conclude December with trips to Ashland, Ore., and Las Vegas for five duals. The Boxers will compete at cross-state rival Southern Oregon on Thursday before heading to Las Vegas for the Wartburg Desert Duals on Monday for four duals against NCAA Division III and NAIA opponents.

**Boxer Bytes**

- Pacific will be trying to snap a string of nine straight dual meet losses. The Boxers lost their last two to a pair of nationally ranked junior college teams on Dec. 5, falling to No. 7 ranked Clackamas CC, 25-21, and to No. 6 ranked Highline CC, 36-6.

- The Boxers will wrestle their only scheduled NCAA Division III duals of the season at the Wartburg Desert Duals. The Boxers will likely not see Division III competition again until the NCAA Great Lakes Regional on Feb. 20.

**Scouting The Opponents**

**SOUTHERN OREGON**



The Raiders enter Thursday's dual with a 3-2 record and are ranked fifth in the NAIA National Coaches Poll. Southern Oregon earned their third win on Wednesday, posting a 45-3 rout of Menlo. The Raiders' two losses came on Dec. 4, falling 27-15 to Missouri Valley and 27-16 to Great Falls. Southern Oregon has seven wrestlers ranked nationally, led by Mitchell Lofstedt's No. 1 ranking at 125 pounds. He entered the week with a 14-2 record with seven pins. Jimmy Eggemeyer (149), Justin Mills (157) and Austin Vanderford (174) all have 11 victories. The Raiders won last year's dual, 1/29/09 in Forest Grove, beating the Boxers 44-6. Mike Ritchey is in his 15th year as Southern Oregon's head coach.

**SIMPSON (IOWA)**



The Storm, NCAA Division III members of the Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference, enters the week with a 0-1 dual meet record. Simpson's one loss came on Nov. 17, falling 22-11 to Cornell (Iowa). A Dec. 9 dual against Luther was postponed. The Storm last competed on Dec. 12 at the North Central College Tournament, finishing fifth with 34 points. Jeff Sand (133), Jordy Ammons (174) and Trent VanDorin (197) all took fifth place in their respective classes. Current overall records for Simpson wrestlers were unavailable. The Boxers and Storm last faced each other on 12/31/02 at the Citrus Duals in Ft. Lauderdale, Fla. Simpson won the dual 26-13. Clint Manny is in his second year as Simpson's head coach.

**ELMHURST**



The Bluejays, members of the College Conference of Illinois & Wisconsin (CCIW), enter the week with a 3-0 record and are ranked 13th in the first NWCA Division III Poll. Elmhurst has opened the year with dual victories over Loras (33-6), Chicago (32-10) and Augustana (Ill.) (38-3) and will face Wheaton (Ill.) on Dec. 17. Ryan Earley has Elmhurst's best record with a 13-3 mark at 141 and 149 pounds. Jake Denhof (133) has 10 wins while Dan Hamilton (157) and Jack Lewis (165) have nine wins each. Pacific and Elmhurst met at last year's Desert Duals, with the Bluejays taking a 46-3 victory. Steve Marianetti is in his seventh season as Elmhurst head coach.

**NORTH CENTRAL**



The Cardinals, also Division III members of the CCIW, enters the week with an 8-2 record and are ranked No. 9 in the NWCA Division III Poll. North Central won their own North Central Tournament on Saturday, capturing five of the 10 weight classes. The Cardinals received victories from Joe Norton at 125, Nathan Fitzenreider at 133, Tim Gingerich at 157, Cowan Brown at 174 and Gabe Youel at 184. Fitzenreider leads North Central with 16 wins. Andrew Zobac has 15 wins at 141 pounds and Youel has 13 victories. Pacific and North Central last competed at the 2006 Desert Duals, with the Cardinals shutting out the Boxers 41-0. Kevin Bratland is in his fourth year as North Central head coach.

**EMBRY-RIDDLE (ARIZ.)**



The NAIA Eagles of Prescott, Ariz., enter the week with an 0-2 record and are ranked 13th in the latest NAIA National Poll. The Eagles last competed on Nov. 28 when they took a 21-15 defeat to Division II Grand Canyon. Overall records for Embry-Riddle's wrestlers were not available. Ryan Luu is currently ranked third at 133 pounds while Joshua Chang is ranked 11th at that weight. Mitchell Newcomer is ranked seventh at 141 pounds, Tyler Chang is seventh at 157 pounds and Trace Billet is 11th at 149 pounds. Ken Ramsey is in his third year as Embry-Riddle head coach.

**Pacific News & Notes**

**PICKING UP WIN NO. 1:** As he makes his adjustment from the 197-pound and heavyweight classes, **Jordan Branson** (Jr., Sheridan, Ore.) has taken his lumps. Branson made a big stride on Dec. 5, picking up his first dual meet victory of the season with a 10-6 decision over Clackamas CC's Nick Dumolt at 174 pounds. Branson dropped to the lower weight classes this season. He currently owns at 2-7 record with a 1-5 mark at 174 pounds and a 1-2 mark at 184 pounds.

**CUSHMAN CONTINUES:** **John Cushman** (So., Lakewood, Wash.) continues to show little effect of having missed a month of practice while completing the cross country season. Cushman improved to 4-4 on the season thanks to a second round pin of Clackamas CC's Levi Root. Cushman enters the week with a 4-4 overall record at 125 pounds. He is tied with **Andy Duncan** (So., Everett, Wash.) for third most wins on the team.

**MATCH RE-SCHEDULED, MENLO CANCELLED:** A conflict with finals forced the cancellation of Pacific's scheduled Dec. 16 match with Menlo and forced the re-scheduling of the Dec. 16 dual with Southern Oregon to Thurs., Dec. 17, Keeping the Dec. 16 would have forced some Pacific wrestlers to miss some final exams. Finals at Pacific concluded on Wednesday.

**AGAINST DIVISION I OPPONENTS:** As the only NCAA Division III wrestling program west of Iowa, the Boxers find Division I competition on their schedule almost every year. Pacific went 0-2 in duals against Division I foes last year, dropping a 43-6 decision to Portland and taking a 43-9 home loss to South Dakota State. Pacific's last dual victory over a Division I opponent came on Jan. 7, 2005, when Pacific edged out South Dakota State 22-20. Over the last decade, Pacific's Division I opponents have included some of the top programs in collegiate wrestling, including Arizona State, Stanford, Cal Poly, Utah Valley State, Wisconsin and Cal State Fullerton.

**TRIP TO SOU OPEN CANCELLED:** Illness forced Pacific to cancel their planned Nov. 14 trip to the Southern Oregon Open in Ashland. According to head coach **Severin Walsh**, all but four of his wrestlers had suffered from illness during either during the week prior or over the weekend. The small number of available wrestlers did not justify the expense of traveling six hours south for the tournament.

**THE LONG ROAD:** Home matches for the 2009-10 Pacific men's wrestling team will be few and far in-between. After opening the season with their annual Mike Clock Open on Nov. 8, the Boxers wrestle their next 11 competitions away from the Pacific Athletic Center. Pacific does not have their next home competition until Fri., Jan. 15, when the Boxers host Yakima Valley CC in a dual. It is the only home dual scheduled for the Boxers this season.
