Wrestling Travels to Ohio Duals

Charleston, S.C. – After a week off from competition following Thanksgiving Break, The Citadel returns to action in the Ohio University Duals on Friday. The Bulldogs will face host Ohio University at 10 a.m. and then face Cleveland State at 11:30 a.m.

In their last competition, The Citadel was represented well at the NC State Open, placing eight wrestlers including a champion. Odie Delaney pinned three on his way to the 197-pound championship. Pierre Frazile went 3-1 on his way to a second place finish while J.C. Oddo, Turtogtokh Luvsandorj and Tyler Sim each were impressive in their third place finishes. Justin Sparrow, Richard Alarcon and Kevin Timothy all took home fourth place finishes from Raleigh.

Ohio has been involved in two tournaments so far this season. The Bobcats placed four in the Hokie Open at Virginia Tech in early November followed by seven wrestlers placing at the Michigan State Open in mid-November. Ohio features three wrestlers ranked in the Top-30 according to WrestlingReport.com.

Cleveland State opened their season with a pair of tournaments in the Eastern Michigan Open and the Michigan State Open. The Vikings then began dual action, falling to Eastern Michigan, 36-6. They followed that dual with a quad meet at Ohio State, falling to the Buckeyes, 51-3, to Findlay, 37-3, and to Notre Dame (OH), 41-3. The Vikings hosted their first dual meet last Tuesday, defeating John Carroll, 31-13.
