HUSKIES HEADLINERS:

- SCSU captured 7th place at the recent NWCA/Cliff Keen Division II National Duals on Jan. 9-10. SCSU gained victories over . SCSU charted wins over #17 San Francisco State (22-10), #14 Fort Hays State (23-13) and #8 Augustana (19-18), while the Huskies suffered losses to #1 Nebraska-Omaha (27-12) and #6 UW-Parkside (19-14). SCSU was seeded #8 in the tournament, and the Huskies are currently ranked #9 in the nation. Of note, the Huskies did not place at the DII duals last year, as they charted a 1-2 record in tournament action there.
- SCSU now owns a 7-4 dual match record in 2009-10.
- Derek Skala charted an impressive 4-1 record at the NWCA Duals in the 184-pound division. His weekend in Iowa included big wins over #3 ranked Austin Boehm of UNO and #6 ranked Nick Henning of Augie. Lucas Munkelwitz also posted a 4-1 record in action at 197-pounds for the Huskies at the NWCA Duals, while teammate Jake Kahnke was 4-1 at heavyweight for the Huskies.
- In the latest NCAA Division II Super Region #3 rankings, the Huskies gained a 2nd place rating with 58 points. Augustana ranked 1st in the region at 59. Individually, John Sundgren (157) and Jacob Roberts (149) were ranked first in the region, while Gabe Suarez (141), Tad Merritt (165), Derek Skala (184), Lucas Munkelwitz (197) and Jacob Kahnke (285) all ranked second in the region poll.
- Tad Merritt and Lucas Munkelwitz are 19-4 this season, while Jake Kahnke improved to 17-3 with their efforts at the NWCA Duals. Of note, Derek Skala is 16-7 this winter at 184-pounds.
- SCSU will be led on the mats this season by team captains junior **Gabe Suarez**, junior **Derek Skala**, junior **John Sundgren** and sophomore **Tad Merritt**.
- The Huskies finished the 2009-10 season with an 8-5 record and a 5-2 record against NSIC schools. SCSU placed second at the 2009 NCAA regional meet and 8th at the 2009 NCAA Division II championships.
- SCSU will open its dual meet season on Jan. 15, with a home date against UW-Eau Claire. Last year, the Huskies earned a 36-6 win at UW-EC. SCSU will then open the NSIC Dual Season on Jan. 16, with a home date against Southwest Minnesota State at 7 p.m. in Halenbeck Hall. Last year, SCSU gained a big 40-6 win in Marshall. Remember, all SCSU students are admitted FREE to all home wrestling matches with a valid student ID card.
- SCSU was ranked 9th in the latest DII national rankings. SCSU's John Sundgren was ranked 5th at 157-pounds, while Derek Skala is 8th at 184-pounds. Lucas Munkelwitz has moved up to 5th at 197-pounds, and Jaco Kahnke is 8th at 285-pounds. SCSU's top ranked grappler is Tad Merritt, with a 3rd place ranking at 165-pounds in the latest poll.
- SCSU gained three All-America awards in 2009. Brad Padgett placed third at 184-pounds, while Tad Merritt was third at 165-pounds. The trio was completed by Derek Skala's seventh place finish at 174-pounds in 2009.
- SCSU's eighth place finish at the 2009 NCAA Division II championships was the Huskies' best NCAA national finish since 1986.
- SCSU will host Augustana on Jan. 22, and then host Nebraska-Omaha on Jan. 23. All home matches are held in SCSU's Halenbeck Hall on the campus of SCSU.



SCSU COACH STEVE COSTANZO: Steve Costanzo is in his fourth season as the Husky head wrestling coach. Costanzo begins his 11th season overall as a college head coach. He has a career record of 93-48-2 while coaching 90 National Qualifiers, 37 All-Americans, 2 National Champions and 28 NWCA All-Academic recipients. His record at St. Cloud State now stands at 32-18. An All-American wrestler at Nebraska-Omaha (1996 graduate), Costanza previously coached at Dana College from 1999 to 2006. Costanza led Dana to a national title in 2006.
