### Dual Meet Schedule Begins To Come To A Close

As the 2009-10 season winds down, the Pacific men's wrestling team begins preparation for its final two dual meets of the season. The Boxers will wrestle one of them this weekend, traveling north to face Highline CC on Saturday. It will be Pacific's final dual of the season against a community college.

### Boxer Bytes

- Pacific came within one match of winning its first dual meet of the season Friday, falling behind in the final match in a 22-19 loss to Yakima Valley CC. It was the Boxers' only home dual match of the season.
- The Boxers finished with a season high five victories in the Yakima Valley match, including victories for Zach Binker, Seth Honl, Kody Kramer, Nathan Shay and Ron Neu.
- Ken Hyland earned his first tournament placing of his college career, placing second in the 157-pound bracket at the Clackamas Open. Hyland went 3-1 in the bracket, tying him with Andrew Wolfe for the the team lead with 11 victories.
- Andrew Wolfe went 3-3 in the 133-pound bracket at the Clackamas Open to finish in sixth place. His three wins included victories over two Division I wrestlers competing unattached.
- Seth Honl has now won seven of his last 11 matches at 141 pounds. He saw a four-match win streak come to an end on Saturday after his first round decision over Southwestern Oregon CC's Orrin Smith at the Clackamas Open.

**HIGHLINE CC**



The Thunderbirds, members of the NJCAA's Region 18, enter the week with a 5-3 record in duals. Highline enters the week ranked seventh in the latest NJCAA National Poll (released Dec. 21). They last competed in Saturday's Clackamas Open. Jason Gray led the way for the Thunderbirds with a second place finish at 149 pounds. Highline last dualled on Wed., Jan. 13, when they lost to No. 3 (NJCAA) ranked North Idaho 23-19. The Thunderbirds boast two wrestlers ranked No. 1 in the NJCAA's national rankings: Jason Gray at 149 pounds and Marshall Giovannini at 157 pounds. Aaron Smith is ranked No. 2 at 133 pounds. Highline and Pacific dualled earlier in the season, Dec. 5 at Oregon City, Ore. **Andrew Wolfe's** (Sr., Milwaukie, Ore.) forfeit at 133 pounds was the Boxers' only scoring in a 36-6 loss.

**Pacific News & Notes**

**FINISHING STRONG:** The Clackamas Open proved to deliver another breakthrough in the young career of **Ken Hyland** (Fr., Medford, Ore.). The freshman earned placing in his first collegiate tournament Saturday, finishing second in the 157-pound bracket. Hyland opened with a pair of close, but solid victories, defeating North Idaho's Alex Martin 5-3 in the opening round and Highline CC's Spencer Kalebac in the quarterfinals by a 12-10 score. Hyland was given a free ride into the finals when Highline's Marshall Giovannini defaulted from the semifinal match. Hyland met Yakima Valley CC's Brad Sweet in the finals, where Hyland fell in a hard-fought 8-3 decision. Hyland has come on for the Boxers during the month of January. He is 7-6 during the month and is now 11-15 overall. Hyland is now tied with **Andrew Wolfe** for the team lead in victories.

**WOLFE FINISHES SIXTH:** **Andrew Wolfe** earned his second tournament placing of the season on Saturday, wrestling to a sixth finish in the 133-pound bracket at the Clackamas Open. Wolfe went 3-3 in his matches at the tournament, earning a spot in the semifinals thanks to a pair of victories over two unattached NCAA Division I competitors. After posting a 5-2 decision over North Idaho's Tracy Huffman in the opening round, Wolfe earned a third round pin of Oregon State's Zach Lowery and then beat Cal State Fullerton's Drew Erickson in the quarterfinals by an 8-2 margin. Wolfe was relegated to the consolation bracket after taking a technical fall in the semifinals to Clackamas CC's Preston Garner. Wolfe is now tied for the team lead in wins with an 11-14 record. He needs just two more victories to tie his Pacific career high for wins at 13.

**HONL KEEPS WINNING:** **Seth Honl's** (Fr., Scappoose, Ore.) winning January just continues to roll on at 141 pounds. The freshman added two more wins to his total, beating Anthony Owens 15-10 in the dual with Yakima Valley CC on Friday. Honl then ran his win streak to four wins by defeating Southwestern Oregon CC's Orrin Smith, 8-3, in the first round of the Clackamas Open. Honl lost his next two matches at the Clackamas Open to go 1-2 in the 141-pound bracket. Honl is now 7-4 during the month in January and now owns an 8-17 overall record.

**Pacific News & Notes**

**NOT AN EASY SCHEDULE:** As Pacific wrestled the bulk of their dual meet season in December and January, the Boxers kept finding themselves coming up against nationally ranked competition. In the Boxers' 13 duals this season, 11 have come against opponents ranked in the top-25 in their respective affiliations. That ledger has included two top-10 NCAA Division III teams (North Central and Coe), a top-5 NAIA team (Southern Oregon), a top-2 National Collegiate Wrestling Association squad (Central Florida) and three top-15 NJCAA programs (Highline CC, Clackamas CC and Southwestern Oregon CC). The Boxers will add another match against a ranked opponent when they face Highline CC again on Saturday.

**SCHEDULE CHANGES:** A conflict with finals forced the cancellation of Pacific's scheduled Dec. 16 match with Menlo and forced the re-scheduling of the Dec. 16 dual with Southern Oregon to Thurs., Dec. 17. Keeping the Dec. 16 would have forced some Pacific wrestlers to miss some final exams. Earlier in the season, the Boxers cancelled their trip to the Nov. 14 Southern Oregon Open in Ashland because of illness to a majority of the Boxers' wrestlers.

**AGAINST DIVISION I OPPONENTS:** As the only NCAA Division III wrestling program west of Iowa, the Boxers find Division I competition on their schedule almost every year. Pacific went 0-2 in duals against Division I foes last year, dropping a 43-6 decision to Portland and taking a 43-9 home loss to South Dakota State. Pacific's last dual victory over a Division I opponent came on Jan. 7, 2005, when Pacific edged out South Dakota State 22-20. Over the last decade, Pacific's Division I opponents have included some of the top programs in collegiate wrestling, including Arizona State, Stanford, Cal Poly, Utah Valley State, Wisconsin and Cal State Fullerton.

**THE LONG ROAD:** The Boxers' one and only home dual is now in the books. After opening the season with their annual Mike Clock Open on Nov. 8, the Boxers wrestled their next 11 competitions away from the Pacific Athletic Center. The Jan. 15 dual against Yakima Valley CC was the only home dual match of the season. The team's final home competition will be the Boxer Open tournament on Sat., Jan. 30.
