#### BIG TEN DUALS

After a rare weekend off, the Golden Gophers will hit the ground running with the opening of Big Ten duals this weekend. Minnesota begins conference action on the road, at Michigan State on Friday Jan. 22, before heading to Michigan just a day later on Jan. 23. Each match is set for a 6:00 p.m. start, and it will be the first conference action for each school.

#### THE RECORDS

The Gophers enter the weekend with a 5-4 record in dual meets, after going 2-2 in their last outing at the Cliff Keen/NWCA National Duals. All four of the No. 5 ranked Gophers losses have come to the teams ranked No. 1 though No. 4. Michigan State will bring a 6-1-1 record into the match, coming off a perfect performance at the Spartan Duals last weekend. Michigan, meanwhile, begins the weekend with a 4-7 record in dual meets and will face off with Iowa before meeting Minnesota.

#### THE SERIES

The Gophers and Spartans have met 61 times in the all-time series with Michigan State holding a slim 31-30 lead. The Gophers and Wolverines have matched up 57 times with Michigan also leading, by a 30-25-2 margin all-time.

#### LAST MATCH-UP

Last season, Minnesota also opened the Big Ten portion of the schedule with Michigan State, claiming a 30-6 victory. The Gophers won eight of 10 matches on their way to the victory. A few weeks later, Michigan came to Minneapolis sporting a No. 18 national ranking and upset the No. 8 ranked Gophers 17-16. Each team won five bouts, but the Wolverines won two of the final three to secure the victory.

#### LAST TIME OUT

Minnesota was off last week, their final weekend off of the season. In their last action on Jan. 9 and 10, the Gophers placed fourth at the National Duals.

#### NEXT UP

The Golden Gophers get to return home for the first time in nearly a month next weekend when they host Wisconsin and Purdue. The Badgers visit first, coming to Williams Arena on Jan. 29 for a 7:00 p.m. match, while the Boilermakers visit two days later on Jan. 31 at 2:00 p.m. in the Sports Pavilion. The Jan. 31 match with Purdue is also the Gopher Wrestling Endowment Meet.

**100 YEARS OF GOPHER WRESTLING**

In 2009-10, Golden Gopher Wrestling will celebrate their 100th year. In the inaugural season of 1910, the legacy of Gopher Wrestling began with it's first conference title at the Western Intercollegiate Wrestling Association Championships. This season will be a year-long celebration of 12 conference titles, 85 individual conference titles, three national titles, 19 individual national titles and the continuing pursuit of excellence that is Gopher Wrestling.

## News and Notes

### NATIONAL RANKINGS

In the latest NWCA Coaches Poll, Minnesota maintained its spot at No. 5, staying there for the second straight week. Minnesota moved to No. 5 after the National Duals where they beat then No. 5 Central Michigan 25-9. The Gophers opened the season at No. 6, and have been ranked in the top-six all season long, including a previous stint at No. 5. Rival Iowa has held the No. 1 spot all season, with Iowa State right behind at No. 2. The Gophers are also fifth in the Inter-Mat and Wrestling Insider News rankings, and sixth in the D1CollegeWrestling.com poll.

### INDIVIDUAL RANKINGS

The Golden Gophers can boast a ranked wrestler at eight of the 10 weight classes, with 157 and 184 as the only exceptions. Jayson Ness and Dustin Schlatter are the highest ranked at No. 2 at 133 and 165 respectively. Four total Gophers can boast top-five rankings (Ness, Sanders, Schlatter, Thorn), with Scott Glasser joining them in the top-10 for the first career time. All the individual rankings can be found on the next page.

### WE'RE WINNIN'

Jayson Ness entered the season with 117 career wins, before tacking on seven more at early season open tournaments. Ness then opened the dual meet portion of the season with four straight wins, and added five more at the Southern Scuffle. After two at the National Duals, he now sits with 19 wins on the season against no losses. His career mark is now 136, moving him into sole possession of fourth place all-time, and just four wins away from third. He is now just four wins away from becoming just the fourth Gopher Wrestler ever with 140 career wins. With the second fewest losses of anyone in the top-10, he is also 23 wins away from tying the Gophers career wins record of 159, which has stood since 1986. To break the record, his season total would need to reach 42, meaning Ness would also set a personal record for wins in a season, bettering his previous best of 40 from his freshman season.

### PIN IT!

As Ness has opened the season with 19 straight victories, the first eight were all by fall. The eight straight pins were a personal best for Ness, and tied the school record set in 1997 by Tim Hartung. Ness won by decision against Oklahoma State, improving his season record, but missing out on a record setting ninth straight fall. He immediately started a new streak, with a pin against Nebraska and ran off another five straight. Of his 17 wins, 14 are by fall.

### EARLY VIEW OF ANN ARBOR

When the Gophers head to Ann Arbor to take on the Wolverines it will be their first trip there since the 2007-08 season, and their first of two trips east this season. The Michigan dual will give Minnesota a chance to become comfortable with their surroundings as they will return to Ann Arbor in February for the Big Ten Championships.

### LAST WIN VS. RANKED OPPONENT

The Gophers improved to 5-2 on the season after beating No. 5 Central Michigan, beating their highest ranked opponent since knocking off No. 5 ranked Ohio State last season on Feb. 21. The Gophers just missed on their bid to take down No. 2 Iowa State, but still have five ranked teams on the schedule with three coming to Minneapolis.

### HOME SCHEDULE

The Gophers welcome some of the nation's best talent to Minnesota this winter, including No. 18 Wisconsin when they return home. Of their seven home dual meets this season, five are with teams currently ranked in the NWCA Top-25, and it started with No. 12 Nebraska on Dec. 10 and No. 2 Iowa State on Jan. 3. The premiere name, though, will be current No. 1 Iowa who comes to Williams Arena on Feb. 14. Also visiting the Gophers this season is No. 15 Penn State on Feb. 19.

### WERE GOIN' STREAKIN'

With his two wins at the National Duals Jayson Ness has now won 21 straight, dating back to last season. With 21 consecutive wins, Ness leads the team, followed by Dustin Schlatter with eight straight. Zach Sanders had an 11-match streak broke at the Southern Scuffle, while Scott Glasser also won 11-straight before a loss at the National Duals. Sonny Yohn had a nine-match winning streak snapped against Oklahoma State.

### WE'RE UNDEFEATED

At 19-0, Jayson Ness is the team win leader, and the last unbeaten among among the regulars. The latest unbeaten to fall was Mario Mason who lost wrestling at the Midlands championships. Zach Sanders dropped his first match of the season at the Southern Scuffle, also falling from the ranks of the unbeaten. Tony Nelson, at 6-0, is the only other Gopher who has yet to lose this season.

### ONE, TWO, THREE TIMES A CHAMPION

Dustin Schlatter will be shooting for his third individual conference title in his final season, after winning Big Ten Championships as a freshman in 2006 and sophomore in 2007. Should he claim his third championship, he will be just the seventh wrestler in Gopher history to win three Individual Big Ten titles, and the first since Cole Konrad in 2007.

### FOUR OUTTA FOUR AIN'T BAD

Jayson Ness and Dustin Schlatter each enter the season as three-time All-Americans. As the season progresses, if they can return to the NCAA championships and once again earn top-eight status, they will become just the second pair of teammates to become four-time All-Americans in the same season. The first were Luke Becker and Jared Lawrence after the 2003 season. They will also become just the sixth and seventh four-time All-Americans in the 100-year history of Golden Gopher Wrestling.

### GOOD CHANCE OF SUCCESS

Dustin Schlatter entered his senior campaign with a career record of 100-7 for a winning percentage of .935, which ranked third all-time. With his 8-1 start this season, his career winning percentage is now .931, still ranking him third all-time. The Minnesota record for career winning percentage is .948 held by Larry Zilverberg (82-4-1) and Brock Lesnar (55-3). Jayson Ness, with a percentage of .899, is eighth all-time.

On the way to his 19-0 mark this year, Jayson Ness notched his first eight, and 14 total by pinfall. Against Oklahoma State, Ness wrestled his first match in the third period this season, and only his second that saw the second period.
