Last Home Event On Horizon As Boxer Open Awaits

The Pacific men's wrestling program will close up the home portion of their 2009-10 schedule this weekend as they host the Boxer Open on Saturday. Following the tournament, the Boxers will have one dual match before final preparations for the NCAA Great Lakes Regional on Feb. 20.

Boxer Bytes

- Pacific saw their dual match with Highline CC slip away thanks to three losses by three points or less and four major decisions in a 40-0 loss to the No. 7 (NJCAA) ranked Thunderbirds on Saturday.
- Seth Honl, Kody Kramer and Nik Streng all came within three points or less of victories against Highline, keeping the Boxers in contention.
- Ken Hyland and Andrew Wolfe became the first Pacific wrestlers to earn 10 wins this season, both improving to 11 victories at the Jan. 16 Clackamas Open.
- Pacific will host its final home event of the season, the Boxer Open tournament, on Saturday. The tournament will be small in scale, featuring select groups of wrestlers from many of the area's local teams.
- After the Boxer Open, Pacific will have one more dual match (at Simon Fraser on Feb. 6) before the season-ending NCAA Great Lakes Regional on Sat., Feb. 20 in Minneapolis, Minn.

BOXER OPEN



Pacific's final tournament of the season will take place in the Pacific Athletic Center's Fieldhouse. The small-scale tournament is expected to feature wrestlers from Pacific, Clackamas CC, Highline CC, Yakima Valley CC and Southwestern Oregon CC along with some unattached wrestlers from Oregon State. No team scores will be kept. **Kody Kramer** (Jr., Oroville, Wash.) was the tournament champion in 2009 at 157 pounds. **Andrew Wolfe** (Sr., Milwaukie, Ore.) finished second at 133 pounds and **Lane Wiltshire** (So., Portland, Ore.) was second at 165 pounds.

Pacific News & Notes

SWAN SONGS: Saturday's Boxer Open will be the final home event for the Boxers' two seniors. **Nathan Shay** (Sr., Gresham, Ore.) has been a regular starter for Pacific for his entire career with most of his matches at 165 pounds. After working through an injury-shortened season in 2007-08, Shay came back to win nine matches in his first season under **Severin Walsh** and went 5-9 in dual meets. Shay stands a chance to make his senior season his best, having already equalled his career best season win total with a 9-17 record. Shay's senior season was highlighted by his two pins at the Wartburg Desert Duals on Dec. 20.

Andrew Wolfe struggled with injuries in both his freshman and sophomore seasons, but recovered to become one of the Boxers' most steady presences. Wolfe finished his junior season with 13 victories, which included a 133-pound championship at the Boxer Open and a fourth place finish at the Oregon Classic. Wolfe has amassed an 11-15 record this season, all at 133 pounds. He has placed sixth this season at both the Northwest Collegiate Wrestling Tournament and the Clackamas Open. Wolfe's run at the Clackamas Open included two wins over unattached NCAA Division I competitors.

HONL KEEPS WINNING: The minor setback that was a loss against Highline CC on Saturday should prove to do little to stop the progress of **Seth Honl** (Fr., Scappoose, Ore.). Honl took a close 10-7 loss to Sam Ottow at 141 pounds on Saturday, but still boasts an 8-5 record in January. Honl has surged in the second half of his freshman season. His nine victories are the second most of any Pacific newcomer behind **Ken Hyland** (Fr., Medford, Ore.) and ties him with **Nathan Shay** for the third most wins on the squad.

TAKING THE HY(LAND) ROAD: Ken Hyland will also be aiming to finish up his freshman season on a strong, positive note. Hyland has dropped his last two matches after rattling off three straight victories at the Clackamas Open on Jan. 16, where he placed second in the 157-pound bracket. Hyland enters the Boxer Open with an 11-16 record, tying him with **Andrew Wolfe** for the most wins on the team.

Pacific News & Notes

NOT AN EASY SCHEDULE: As Pacific wrestled the bulk of their dual meet season in December and January, the Boxers kept finding themselves coming up against nationally ranked competition. In the Boxers' 14 duals this season, 12 have come against opponents ranked in the top-25 in their respective affiliations. That ledger has included two top-10 NCAA Division III teams (North Central and Coe), a top-5 NAIA team (Southern Oregon), a top-2 National Collegiate Wrestling Association squad (Central Florida) and three top-15 NJCAA programs (Highline CC twice, Clackamas CC and Southwestern Oregon CC). Simon Fraser, who is currently ranked No. 11 in the NAIA poll, would be the 13th ranked opponent should they maintain their ranking for their dual against Pacific on Feb. 6.

SCHEDULE CHANGES: A conflict with finals forced the cancellation of Pacific's scheduled Dec. 16 match with Menlo and forced the re-scheduling of the Dec. 16 dual with Southern Oregon to Thurs., Dec. 17. Keeping the Dec. 16 would have forced some Pacific wrestlers to miss some final exams. Earlier in the season, the Boxers cancelled their trip to the Nov. 14 Southern Oregon Open in Ashland because of illness to a majority of the Boxers' wrestlers.

AGAINST DIVISION I OPPONENTS: As the only NCAA Division III wrestling program west of Iowa, the Boxers find Division I competition on their schedule almost every year. Pacific went 0-2 in duals against Division I foes last year, dropping a 43-6 decision to Portland and taking a 43-9 home loss to South Dakota State. Pacific's last dual victory over a Division I opponent came on Jan. 7, 2005, when Pacific edged out South Dakota State 22-20. Over the last decade, Pacific's Division I opponents have included some of the top programs in collegiate wrestling, including Arizona State, Stanford, Cal Poly, Utah Valley State, Wisconsin and Cal State Fullerton.

THE LONG ROAD: The Boxers' one and only home dual is now in the books. After opening the season with their annual Mike Clock Open on Nov. 8, the Boxers wrestled their next 11 competitions away from the Pacific Athletic Center. The Jan. 15 dual against Yakima Valley CC was the only home dual match of the season. The team's final home competition will be the Boxer Open tournament on Sat., Jan. 30.
