HOME SWEET HOME

The Gophers get to return home this weekend, for the first time in nearly a month. The last home match was way back on Jan. 3, but this weekend, Minnesota is home for two, hosting Wisconsin and Purdue. On Jan. 29 in Williams Arena the Gophers host the Badgers in a Border Battle at 7:00 p.m. Two days later, this time in the Sports Pavilion, the Gophers host the Boilermakers for a 2:00 p.m. matinee.

THE NEXT 100 YEARS

Against Purdue on Jan. 31, it will be the Golden Gopher Wrestling Endowment Meet. 100% of the ticket revenue will go directly to fund scholarships for the Minnesota Wrestling team. When fans buy tickets, they will be making a donation to the future of Golden Gopher wrestling, and one that a student-athlete will directly benefit from.

THE RECORDS

Following two wins last weekend, Minnesota enters the week with a 7-4 overall record and a 2-0 mark in Big Ten action. Wisconsin enters with a 5-6 mark overall and a 1-0 record in the Big Ten. Purdue is 10-5 on the season and has split their two matches to open the Big Ten season and sits at 1-1.

THE SERIES

Only Iowa and Iowa State matched up with the Gophers more than the 88 times they have faced Wisconsin. In the series that started in 1926, the Gophers hold a 55-32-1 edge on the Badgers. Minnesota and Purdue have met 62 times, also starting in 1926, with the Gophers leading 43-17-2 in the all-time series.

LAST MATCH-UP

The Gophers and Badgers met last season in Madison, Wis. with the 18th ranked and host Badgers pulling the upset over the 11th ranked Gophers, 19-15. With Minnesota up 12-7 at the break, Wisconsin won four straight after the intermission to seal the upset.

FOLLOW ALONG

The Gophers will be highly visible this weekend for fans that can't make it to Williams Arena and the Sports Pavilion. Against Wisconsin, the match will be streamed live on BigTenNetwork.com. Log on to GopherSports.com and the Wrestling schedule page to access the link. The match with Purdue will be broadcast on a tape delay on Big Ten Network, with the showing at 10:00 p.m. Sunday. Check your local listing for station information and availability.

LAST TIME OUT

Last weekend Minnesota opened the Big Ten season with two road wins, at Michigan State and Michigan. On Jan. 22, the Gophers came from behind to beat the Spartans 18-16, using wins at 197 and heavyweight to do so. A night later, the Gophers won eight of 10 bouts to score a 30-6 win over Michigan.

NEXT UP

Next week, the Gophers are back on the road, as they take on the Illini and the Hoosiers. On Friday, Feb. 5 Minnesota is at No. 24 Illinois, and a day later on Saturday Feb. 6, they are at No. 14 Indiana.

100 YEARS OF GOPHER WRESTLING

In 2009-10, Golden Gopher Wrestling will celebrate their 100th year. In the inaugural season of 1910, the legacy of Gopher Wrestling began with it's first conference title at the Western Intercollegiate Wrestling Association Championships. This season will be a year-long celebration of 12 conference titles, 85 individual conference titles, three national titles, 19 individual national titles and the continuing pursuit of excellence that is Gopher Wrestling.

News and Notes

THE NEXT 100 YEARS

Golden Gopher Wrestling fans, you can help build for the next century, and it's as easy as coming to the meet. When Minnesota hosts Purdue on Jan. 31, it will be the Golden Gopher Wrestling Endowment Meet. 100% of the ticket revenue against Purdue will go directly to fund scholarships for the Minnesota Wrestling team. When fans buy their tickets, they will be making a donation to the future of Golden Gopher wrestling, and one that a student-athlete will directly benefit from.

NATIONAL RANKINGS

In the latest NWCA Coaches Poll, Minnesota maintained its spot at No. 5, staying there for the third straight week. Minnesota first moved to No. 5 after they beat then No. 5 Central Michigan 25-9 on Jan. 10. The Gophers opened the season at No. 6, and have been ranked in the top-six all season long, including a previous stint at No. 5. Rival Iowa has held the No. 1 spot all season, with Iowa State right behind at No. 2. The Gophers are also fifth in the D1CollegeWrestling.com, InterMat and Wrestling Insider News rankings.

INDIVIDUAL RANKINGS

The Golden Gophers can boast a ranked wrestler at eight of the 10 weight classes, with 157 and 184 as the only exceptions. Jayson Ness and Dustin Schlatter are the highest ranked at No. 2 at 133 and 165 respectively. Four total Gophers can boast top-five rankings (Ness, Sanders, Schlatter, Thorn), with Scott Glasser joining them in the top-10. All the individual rankings can be found on the next page.

WE'RE WINNIN'

Jayson Ness entered the season with 117 career wins, before tacking on seven more at early season open tournaments. Ness then opened the dual meet portion of the season with four straight wins, and added five more at the Southern Scuffle. After two at the National Duals, he now sits with 19 wins on the season against no losses. His career mark is now 136, moving him into sole possession of fourth place all-time, and just six wins away from third. He is also now just four wins away from becoming just the fourth Gopher Wrestler ever with 140 career wins. With the second fewest losses of anyone in the top-10, he is also 23 wins away from tying the Gophers career wins record of 159, which has stood since 1986. To break the record, his season total would need to reach 42, meaning Ness would also set a personal record for wins in a season, bettering his previous best of 40 from his freshman season.

PIN IT!

As Ness has opened the season with 19 straight victories, the first eight were all by fall. The eight straight pins were a personal best for Ness, and tied the school record set in 1997 by Tim Hartung. Ness won by decision against Oklahoma State, improving his season record, but missing out on a record setting ninth straight fall. He immediately started a new streak, with a pin against Nebraska and ran off another five straight. Of his 19 wins, 14 are by fall.

LAST WIN VS. RANKED OPPONENT

The Gophers improved to 5-2 on the season after beating No. 5 Central Michigan, beating their highest ranked opponent since knocking off No. 5 ranked Ohio State last season on Feb. 21. The Gophers just missed on their bid to take down No. 2 Iowa State, but still have all six of their remaining opponents among the top-25.

HOME SCHEDULE

The Gophers welcome some of the nation's best talent to Minnesota this winter, including No. 12 Wisconsin and No. 25 Purdue this weekend. Of their seven home dual meets this season, five are with teams currently ranked in the NWCA Top-25. It started with No. 12 Nebraska on Dec. 10 and No. 2 Iowa State on Jan. 3. The premiere name, though, will be current No. 1 Iowa who comes to Williams Arena on Feb. 14. Also visiting the Gophers this season is No. 15 Penn State on Feb. 19.

WERE GOIN' STREAKIN'

19-0 Jayson Ness has won 21 straight matches, dating back to last season. With 21 consecutive wins, Ness leads the team, followed by Dustin Schlatter with eight straight. Zach Sanders had an 11-match streak broke at the Southern Scuffle, while Scott Glasser also won 11-straight before a loss at the National Duals. Sonny Yohn had a nine-match winning streak snapped against Oklahoma State.

WE'RE UNDEFEATED

At 19-0, Jayson Ness is the team win leader, and the last unbeaten among among the regulars. The last unbeaten to fall was Mario Mason who lost wrestling at the Midlands championships. Zach Sanders dropped his first match of the season at the Southern Scuffle, also falling from the ranks of the unbeaten. Tony Nelson, at 6-0, is the only other Gopher who has yet to lose this season.

ONE, TWO, THREE TIMES A CHAMPION

Dustin Schlatter will be shooting for his third individual conference title in his final season, after winning Big Ten Championships as a freshman in 2006 and sophomore in 2007. Should he claim his third championship, he will be just the seventh wrestler in Gopher history to win three Individual Big Ten titles, and the first since Cole Konrad in 2007.

Jayson Ness and Dustin Schlatter each enter the season as three-time All-Americans. As the season progresses, if they can return to the NCAA championships and once again earn top-eight status, they will become just the second pair of teammates to become four-time All-Americans in the same season. The first were Luke Becker and Jared Lawrence after the 2003 season. They will also become just the sixth and seventh four-time All-Americans in the 100-year history of Golden Gopher Wrestling.
