HUSKIES HEADLINERS:

- SCSU received an 8th place seed for the 2010 NWCA Division II Duals, which will be held on Jan. 9-10, at the University of Northern Iowa in Cedar Falls. SCSU will open tournament action with a dual match against San Francisco State at 9 a.m. on Jan. 9. SCSU is one of only 16 teams for the NCAA Division II to be selected for participation in this annual event. Last year, SCSU posted a 1-2 record at the NWCA Duals. Other NSIC schools selected to participate in the NWCA Duals this year include #7 seed Augustana and unseeded Minnesota State Mankato. Former NCC rival Nebraska-Omaha is the tournament's top seed.
- Over the Holiday break, SCSU travelled to the elite Midlands Championships in Evanston, Ill. on Dec. 29-30. The Huskies placed 34th as a team at the tournament, which features many of the nation's top NCAA Division I programs including Midlands team champion Iowa. At the Midlands Championships, sophomore Tad Merritt earned a prestigious #12 seed in the 165-pound bracket. Merritt concluded the tournament with a 2-2 record, which included wins over Northern Illinois' John Odeen and Dubuque's Josh Terrell. At 184-pounds, Derek Skala also posted a 2-2 record that included a 3-2 win over UN-Kearney's Derek Ross and a 12-6 win over Illinois' Matt McCarter. Other SCSU wrestlers in action at the Midlands were Gabe Suarez (141), Shamus O'Grady (174) and Lucas Munkelwitz (197).
- In the latest NCAA Division II Super Region #3 rankings, the Huskies gained a 2nd place rating with 58 points. Augustana ranked 1st in the region at 59. Individually, John Sundgren (157) and Jacob Roberts (149) were ranked first in the region, while Gabe Suarez (141), Tad Merritt (165), Derek Skala (184), Lucas Munkelwitz (197) and Jacob Kahnke (285) all ranked second in the region poll.
- Tad Merritt is 16-2 this season, while Gabe Suarez is 8-2 on the season. Luke Munkelwitz is also doing well with a solid 15-3 record this winter. Other top SCSU wrestlers include Derek Skala (12-6), Jake Kahnke (13-2) and John Sundgren (7-2).
- SCSU will be led on the mats this season by team captains junior **Gabe Suarez**, junior **Derek Skala**, junior **John Sundgren** and sophomore **Tad Merritt**.
- The Huskies finished the 2009-10 season with an 8-5 record and a 5-2 record against NSIC schools. SCSU placed second at the 2009 NCAA regional meet and 8th at the 2009 NCAA Division II championships.
- SCSU was ranked 9th in the latest DII national rankings. SCSU's John Sundgren was ranked 5th at 157-pounds, while Derek Skala is 8th at 184-pounds. Lucas Munkelwitz has moved up to 5th at 197-pounds, and Jacob Kahnke is 8th at 285-pounds. SCSU's top ranked grappler is Tad Merritt, with a 3rd place ranking at 165-pounds this week..
- SCSU gained three All-America awards in 2009. Brad Padgett placed third at 184-pounds, while Tad Merritt was third at 165-pounds. The trio was completed by Derek Skala's seventh place finish at 174-pounds in 2009.
- SCSU's eighth place finish at the 2009 NCAA Division II championships was the Huskies' best NCAA national finish since 1986.



SCSU COACH STEVE COSTANZO: Steve Costanzo is in his fourth season as the Husky head wrestling coach. Costanzo begins his 11th season overall as a college head coach. He has a career record of 90-46-2 while coaching 90 National Qualifiers, 37 All-Americans, 2 National Champions and 28 NWCA All-Academic recipients. His record at St. Cloud State now stands at 29-16. An All-American wrestler at Nebraska-Omaha (1996 graduate), Costanza previously coached at Dana College from 1999 to 2006. Costanza led Dana to a national title in 2006.
