TOM MCDANIEL

2010 HONOREE

Tom McDaniel has had a positive influence on athletics in Oklahoma with a legacy that will continue for many years.

During his nine-year tenure as president of Oklahoma City University, the Athletic Department has added programs in rowing, volleyball, men's and women's wrestling, cross country, track and field, competitive cheerleading and pom. It also built Ann Lacy Stadium for softball, renovated the wrestling practice area, improved Jim Wade Stadium for baseball and opened the Steve and Suzan Knight Strength and Conditioning Facility for all Stars athletes to use.

In June of last year, OCU broke ground on the \$10 million Devon Boathouse, home of OCU Rowing, and celebrated the designation of the Oklahoma City High Performance Training Center as a U.S. Olympic training site.

OCU's annual regatta, which began in 2004, has become one of the best in the nation, drawing praise from USRowing and participating teams from across the country. Another annual athletic competition started under McDaniel's leadership includes the Marianne Vannatta Race with the Stars, which raises scholarship funds for the Kramer School of Nursing. OCU hosted the NAIA Wrestling National Championship in 2009 and 2010.

OCU has won 18 national championships since McDaniel's arrival and the student-athletes have held at least a 3.0 grade-point average in each semester.

McDaniel and his wife Brenda are considered OCU's most dedicated fans. They regularly attend Stars athletic events of all kinds to cheer on their beloved student-athletes.

His positive contributions to student athletics extend to his alma mater Northwestern Oklahoma State University in Alva with the Tom McDaniel Scholarship. The scholarship is for student-athletes who best represent McDaniel's characteristics of leadership, dedication and academic merit. He is a former president of the Oklahoma City Golf and Country Club, which is one of the many civic leadership roles he has held.

McDaniel received a bachelor's degree in business from Northwestern Oklahoma State University in 1960 and his juris doctor degree from the University of Oklahoma College of Law in 1963, after which he was in private law practice. In 1981, the Supreme Court of Oklahoma appointed him as administrative director of state courts. He joined Kerr-McGee in 1984, ultimately becoming vice chairman of the company and a member of its board of directors. A member of the Oklahoma and American Bar associations, McDaniel is a former state chairman of the Oklahoma Fellows of the American Bar Foundation.

He was inducted into the Oklahoma Hall of Fame in 2006. He was named Friday newspaper's 2004 OKCITYAN of the Year and in 2005 was honored with the Oklahoma City Plaza District inaugural Urban Pioneer Award for his work in the central city.

McDaniel and his wife were married in 1959. They have three grown sons – Lance, Randy and Mark – and four grandchildren.
