Season Comes To Its Summit As Regional Meet Awaits

Four months of preparation and learning for a young Pacific men's wrestling program comes to the championships season on Saturday. Pacific heads east this weekend, participating in the NCAA Division III Great Lakes Regional in Minneapolis. Augsburg College, one of the perennial powers in Division III wrestling, is this year's tournament host.

Boxer Bytes

- Pacific concluded their 2009-10 dual meet season with a heartbreaking loss. After winning their first three matches, the Boxers gave up three pins and lost six of the next seven in a 28-18 defeat to Simon Fraser on Feb. 6.
- **Seth Honl** won two matches, taking his 141-pound match in the Simon Fraser dual over Raj Virdi and an exhibition match over Southern Oregon's Joe Hutchinson. Honl has now gone 12-7 since Jan. 1 and is 13-20 overall.
- **Andrew Wolfe** earned his team-leading 14th victory and fifth pin of the season against Simon Fraser, scoring a second round fall over J.J. Lum at 133 pounds.
- Pacific will aim to improve on last year's 15th place finish at the NCAA Great Lakes Regional. The always powerful region includes a number of ranked foes, including No. 1 Augsburg, No. 8 Elmhurst, No. 6 Concordia-Moorhead and No. 11 St. John's (Minn.).

Scouting The Tournament

NCAA DIVISION III GREAT LAKES REGIONAL



Pacific will be aiming to improve on what was a disappointing 15th place finish at the 2009 edition of the Great Lakes Regional, where the Boxers scored just seven points. **Andrew Wolfe** (Sr., Milwaukie, Ore.) was the Boxers' top finishing wrestler, scoring two victories at 133 pounds. The going will not be easy, though, as the Boxers will wrestle in what is arguably the toughest Division III regional in the nation. Tournament host Augsburg enters the meet ranked No. 1 in the latest Brute/Adidas Division III National Poll. They have won seven straight regional titles since joining the Great Lakes Region for the 2003 season. Also competing within the region are No. 8 Elmhurst, No. 9 Concordia-Moorhead and No. 11 St. John's (Minn.).

Despite recent performances, the Boxers have enjoyed a rich history in their 12 years as a member of the region. Pacific won three of the first four Great Lakes Regionals it competed in, capturing titles in 1999, 2000 and 2002 while finishing second in 2001.

Pacific News & Notes

A CONTINUED IMPROVEMENT: If the Pacific wrestling team gave an award for Most Improved Wrestler, no doubt the award would go to **Seth Honl** (Fr., Scappoose, Ore.) After winning just one match before the Christmas Break, Honl has hit stride by going 12-7 since that time. Honl added two victories on Feb. 6. He took the 141-pound match in the dual with Simon Fraser, scoring a 10-3 decision over Raj Virdi. He added an exhibition victory over Southern Oregon's Joe Hutchinson, taking an 11-6 decision. Honl enters the Great Lakes Regional with a 13-20 record at 141 pounds, which is the second most victories for the Boxers this season. He concluded the dual meet season with a 5-10 mark. Since Jan. 1, Honl won all but one of his matches in dual meets.

SETTING UP FOR A STRONG FINISH: **Andrew Wolfe** appears to be setting up for a strong finish to his Pacific career at the Great Lakes Regional. Wolfe enters the tournament on a three-match win streak. He won both of his matches at the Jan. 30 Boxer Open and scored a second round pin over Simon Fraser's J.J. Lum in the Feb. 6 dual. Wolfe enters the Great Lakes Regional with a team best 14-15 record, which is the most wins of his Pacific career. Wolfe was Pacific's top placer at last year's regional, winning two matches in the 133-pound bracket.

SENIOR SENDOFF: **Nathan Shay** (Sr., Gresham, Ore.) will also look to finish off his Pacific career with a strong effort at the Great Lakes Regional. Shay enters the tournament with 12 victories, tied for third best on the team. He dropped a close 7-3 decision in the dual with Simon Fraser at 165 pounds to Max Arcand. Like **Andrew Wolfe**, the 12 victories are the most in Shay's Pacific career. Unlike his first three seasons, Shay has spent the entire season wrestling at 165 pounds.

Pacific News & Notes

HY-LANDER: Like teammate Seth Honl, Ken Hyland (Fr., Medford, Ore.) also stands a chance of finishing his freshman season off on a strong note. Hyland enters the Great Lakes Regional with 10 victories, with all of his matches at 157 pounds. He will be looking to end a four-match losing streak. He has not won since scoring an 8-4 decision over Joseph Fistolera of Clackamas CC at the Jan. 30 Boxer Open.

KRAMER LOOKING FOR MORE THAN ONE: Kody Kramer (Jr., Oroville, Wash.) will aim to win more than one match at the Great Lakes Regional in 2010. The junior has won one match at each of his first two regional tournaments. He will drop back down to 149 pounds after wrestling last year's tournament at 157 pounds. Kramer's last win came at the Jan. 30 Boxer Open, when he scored a win over a Division I foe with an 11-2 major decision over Oregon State's Brian Tostberg.

NOT AN EASY SCHEDULE: As Pacific wrestled the bulk of their dual meet season in December and January, the Boxers kept finding themselves coming up against nationally ranked competition. In the Boxers' 15 duals this season, 13 have come against opponents ranked in the top-25 in their respective affiliations. That ledger has included two top-10 NCAA Division III teams (North Central and Coe), two top-10 NAIA teams (Southern Oregon and Simon Fraser), a top-2 National Collegiate Wrestling Association squad (Central Florida) and three top-15 NJCAA programs (Highline CC twice, Clackamas CC and Southwestern Oregon CC).

SCHEDULE CHANGES: A conflict with finals forced the cancellation of Pacific's scheduled Dec. 16 match with Menlo and forced the re-scheduling of the Dec. 16 dual with Southern Oregon to Thurs., Dec. 17. Keeping the Dec. 16 would have forced some Pacific wrestlers to miss some final exams. Earlier in the season, the Boxers cancelled their trip to the Nov. 14 Southern Oregon Open in Ashland because of illness to a majority of the Boxers' wrestlers.

AGAINST DIVISION I OPPONENTS: As the only NCAA Division III wrestling program west of Iowa, the Boxers find Division I competition on their schedule almost every year. Pacific went 0-2 in duals against Division I foes last year, dropping a 43-6 decision to Portland and taking a 43-9 home loss to South Dakota State. Pacific's last dual victory over a Division I opponent came on Jan. 7, 2005, when Pacific edged out South Dakota State 22-20. Over the last decade, Pacific's Division I opponents have included some of the top programs in collegiate wrestling, including Arizona State, Stanford, Cal Poly, Utah Valley State, Wisconsin and Cal State Fullerton.
