Wrestling Travels to Davidson for SoCon Dual on Thursday Night

Charleston, S.C. – The Citadel wrestling squad will travel to Davidson, N.C. on Thursday to compete in their final Southern Conference dual of the season.

The Bulldogs (6-5, 1-3) are coming off a sweep at the Anderson Duals last Thursday in which they crushed the host Trojans, 33-2 and ran past Limestone, 29-3. The Citadel will look to win their sixth road dual of the year as they sport a 5-2 record in duals away from McAlister Field House this season.

Eight Bulldogs went 2-0 last week as Jordan Dix, Nick LaFevre, Derek Royster, Turtogtokh Luvsandorj, Pierre Frazile, Justin Sparrow, Kelby Smith and Odie Delaney all went undefeated. Richard Alarcon and Giazzi Segarra each went 1-0 as well. LaFevre defeated nationally ranked Jeremy Parker of Limestone, 2-1. Parker is ranked fifth nationally in Division II. Luvsandorj, Dix and Smith all registered major decisions for the Bulldogs, while Segarra and Delaney each had pins last Thursday.

Davidson (2-12, 0-3) is led by 125-pound grappler Ben Altman who sports a 17-10 overall record with four pins. He is 7-6 in dual action and 0-2 in the SoCon. The Wildcats have participated in the Hokie Open, the Pembroke Open and the Davidson Open. They have dual wins over Franklin & Marshall and Millersville, with losses to No. 17 Illinois, Pittsburgh, Rider, Binghamton, Duke, Chattanooga, Pitt-Johnstown, Millersville, The Apprentice School, Gardner-Webb, VMI and UNCG.

The series history has been all one-sided as The Citadel has never lost to Davidson. Available records indicate the Bulldogs are 46-0 against the Wildcats, dating back to the 1963-1964 season. Last year at Davidson, The Citadel won 22-16. The last meeting in Charleston came in the 2007-2008 season when the Bulldogs rolled, 31-6, at McAlister Field House.
