

Ervin 3-0, Apps 0-3 at Wendy's Duals

ASHLAND, Ohio—Scott Ervin continued his perfect duals record with three victories at the Wendy's Duals in Ashland, Ohio, on Sunday, but it wasn't enough to keep Appalachian from going winless at the event.

The Mountaineers drop to 4-13 on the season with the three losses.

The day got off to a promising start for ASU, as a decision by Frank Celorrio combined with a Scott Ervin pin and Clinton Swango's win by forfeit lifted the Mountaineers to a 15-3 lead over Ohio University after four matches. Appalachian couldn't find their rhythm for the rest of the meet, though, as the Bobcats took the last six matches and ASU was deducted a team point to cap a 25-14 comeback win.

Against their second opponent, Ohio State, Appalachian got off to a slow start and never recovered. Ervin and Neal Martin both posted decisions, and Dave Hazell won by forfeit at heavyweight to account for ASU's team points, but three major decisions and a pin helped the Buckeyes prevail 30-12.

The Mountaineers concluded the day with a matchup against No. 21 Kent State. Again, Ervin, Martin and Hazell posted wins for ASU, but the Golden flashes were too much to overcome and took the match 27-10.

No. 18 Scott Ervin, courtesy of his three wins on Sunday, improves his record to 18-2 overall. En route, Ervin defeated No. 19 Lance Palmer of Ohio State 7-4 for his second victory over a ranked opponent this season. In his first match, the junior picked up his seventh pin of the season, coming 4:30 in against Ohio's Clay Tucker. Ervin rounded out the day with a 14-4 major decision over Patrick Lanham of Kent State.
