meet alongside the 20th annual Cadet Nationals for the ninth straight year. With 4,327 combined entries, it is the largest amateur wrestling tournament in the world.

The ASICS/Vaughan Junior National Wrestling Championships feature wrestlers in grades 9-12 with representatives of USA

Wrestling's 49 state associations. The ASICS/Vaughan Cadet National Championships include the top 15-16 year-old wrestlers in the United States.
