## Oklahoma State Wins Fourth Straight NCAA Wrestling Title

**O**KLAHOMA CITY - Johny Hendricks set off Oklahoma State's celebration of its fourth straight national title Saturday night with a dramatic victory in the 165-pound finals.

Jake Rosholt became the 15th Oklahoma State wrestler to win three national titles and the Cowboys finished with 122 1/2 points for their 34th overall title. Minnesota, which also had two NCAA champions, finished second with 84 points and Oklahoma was third with 80 1/2.

Hendricks scored a takedown with 4 seconds left to beat top-seeded Ryan Churella of Michigan 8-7 for his second straight championship. Afterward, he pumped both arms, yelled "That's two!" to the Cowboys' fans, then ran over and lifted coach John Smith into the air with a bear hug.

Smith then guided Hendricks toward the ringside steps, but that didn't stop him. He led a large section of orange-clad fans in an "O-S-U" chant, grabbed an Oklahoma State flag from a fan on the arena floor and carried it over his shoulders.

"I looked up and saw 3 seconds left and I went to my crowd after that," Hendricks said.

Churella, who had taken a 7-4 lead with a four-point move at the end of the second period, complained to the referee, but to no avail.

Even in the interview room, Hendricks—known for drawing motivation from the ire of opposing fans—still hadn't settled down.

"In my mind, I'm still cheering over there with OSU fans," Hendricks said.

Rosholt followed with a 10-3 win against Penn State's Phil Davis to win the 197-pound title, then leaped into the crowd to

celebrate.

Minnesota heavyweight Cole Konrad spoiled part of Oklahoma State's joy by beating two-time champion Steve Mocco with an escape in the third overtime period. He piled on a takedown to complete a 5-2 victory. It was the third time Konrad beat Mocco after losing to Mocco in overtime in last year's finals. The three losses were Mocco's only defeats in his last 101 matches.

Freshman Dustin Schlatter won Minnesota's other title in a 4-0 decision over Iowa 149-pounder Tyler Eustice.

Although it came to a familiar finish, this wasn't a normal season for college wrestling's most successful program.

The Cowboys lost twice in the regular season to Minnesota, which came in as the favorite but fell behind in the tournament as a result of a series of early upsets.

Oklahoma State capitalized by sending its four defending champions and sophomore 133-pounder Nathan Morgan to the semifinals and locking up the title on the second day.

The Cowboys sealed their longest run as national champions since they won seven straight titles from 1937 to 1946 – a span that included three years without an NCAA tournament because of World War II. It's the third time the school has won four or more wrestling titles in a row.

No school has won as many NCAA wrestling titles as Oklahoma State. Iowa ranks second with 20 titles, and no one else has more than eight.

"That is exactly how our season was," Hendricks said. "We were up and got knocked down at the national duals by Minnesota. We got back up, we got knocked down by Minnesota. It shows that hard work, great coaching will pay off at the end."

Indiana's Joe Dubuque defended his 125-pound title by scoring takedowns against Cornell freshman Troy Nickerson in each period on his way to an 8-3 victory. He became Indiana's first ever back-to-back NCAA champion and joined Charles McDaniel, who won heavyweight titles in 1935 and 1938, as the school's only two-time champions.

"I hardly ever get nervous. I get in the spotlight and I just have fun," said Dubuque, who flexed for the crowd and pointed to the sky after his win. "I see those

people, I feed off their energy. It's just great. I love being in the spotlight. I love being on top."

Several Missouri fans wore afro wigs to mimic 174-pounder Ben Askren, who won the Tigers' first-ever NCAA title. At 184 pounds, Shane Webster won Oregon's first NCAA title since 1969 – when 115-pounder John Miller won the Ducks only other championship.

Penn's Matthew Valenti used a riding time advantage to beat Purdue's Christopher Fleeger 3-2 in the 133-pound final and Iowa State's Nate Gallick avenged a loss in last year's 141-pound title match by beating two-time champion Teyon Ware of Oklahoma 3-2.

Ben Cherrington completed a 20-0 season by beating Arizona State's Brian Stith 7-3 at 157 pounds to become the second NCAA champion for Boise State.

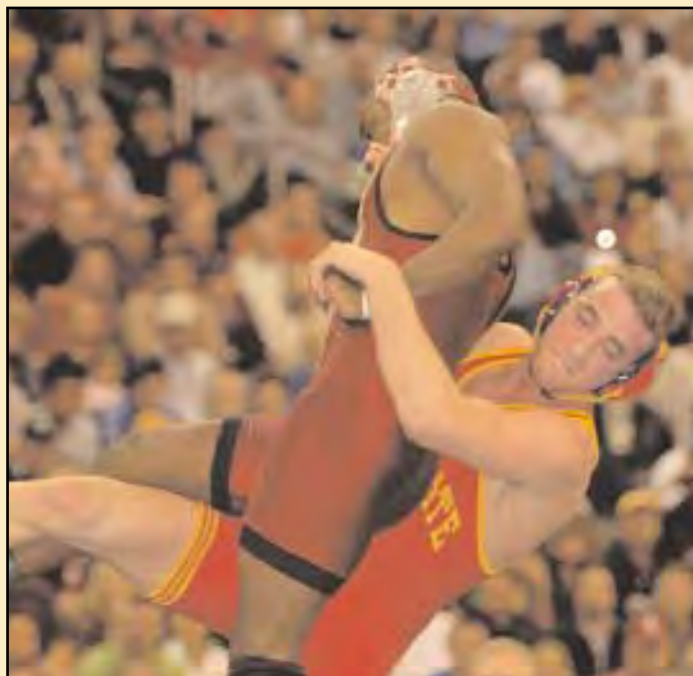

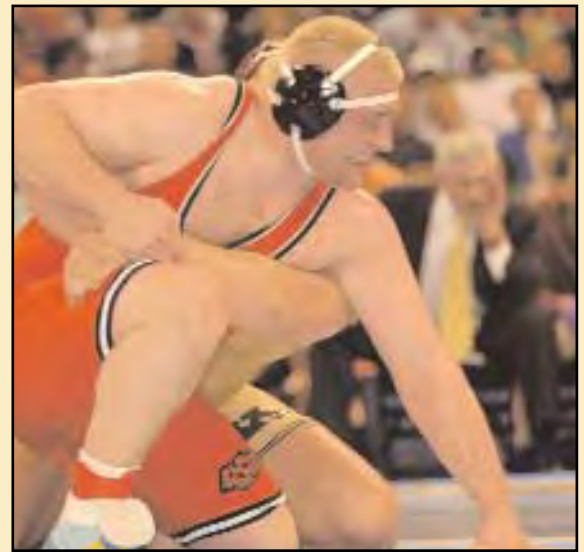
