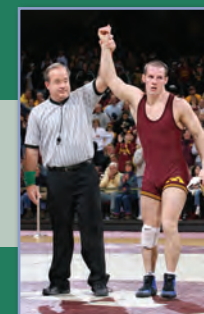

"Training Champions"

Owen Team Camp provides half of the live matches in one week that wrestlers would normally receive in one full season of high school competition.



TECHNIQUE CAMP

- Three technique sessions daily
- Swimming
- Organized games
- Takedown tournament last evening of camp
- Large and small group method of instruction
- Live wrestling after morning session
- Camp store open during camp hours
- We welcome age 10 through grade 12
- Tournament at end of camp

TEAM CAMP

- Weigh in at check-in
- Official state weight classes, plus a 3-pound allowance
- Three sessions of wrestling held daily
- Morning session focuses on technique
- Dual meet competitions at afternoon and evening session
- Team champion will be crowned at the end of camp following the weekly pool competition
- Awards will be presented to each member of the winning team
- Each wrestler will compete in an individual takedown tournament on the last evening of camp.

FEATURED CLINICIANS



MIKE ZADICK, 2008 Olympian, Assistant Coach at the University of Iowa. Zadick was a three-time All-American at Iowa and was a silver medalist at the 2006 World Championships. He is a former four-time Montana State Champion from Great Falls, MT. Zadick is a current world team member.



DUSTIN SCHLATTER, three-time All-American at the University of Minnesota and the 2006 NCAA National Champion. Schlatter is a former four-time Ohio State Champion and High School National Champion. He was a 2009 USA World Team Member in Freestyle.



TYLER SHERFEY, Head Wrestling Coach at Mountain View HS in Boise, ID. He was an All-American for Boise State in 2009, and a four-time NCAA National Tournament qualifier. Tyler is a former two-time Washington State Champion at Richland HS in Richland, WA.



ANDREW HOCHSTRASSER, from Boise State University, he was an All-American in 2009, placing fourth in the NCAA Tournament for BSU. Hochstrasser is currently ranked second in the nation at 133 pounds. He is a former four-time Utah State Champion.

PERMANENT STAFF



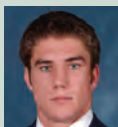
JOHN OWEN, Camp Director, is Head Coach at West Valley H.S. and former Head Coach at North Idaho College with eight national junior college team championships. Owen coached over 100 junior college All-Americans, and 35 individual national champions.



COREY OWEN, Head Wrestling Coach at Lake City HS in Coeur d'Alene, ID. A Dickinson State University Graduate, Corey wrestled for 2 years at North Idaho College. He is a former two-time state champion from Missoula Sentinel HS.



CURTIS OWEN, Assistant Coach at Chandler H.S. in Phoenix, Arizona, Curtis took 4th place at the 2003 NCAA National Tournament and was the 2003 1st team Academic All-American, Junior College National Champion at NIC, and two-time Montana State Champion.



PAT OWEN, Assistant Coach at Harvard University, Pat is a Career 100 Win Club at the University of Michigan. He came in 2nd at the 2003 Las Vegas Invitational, was NCAA National Tournament Qualifier in 2003-2004, and a former three-time Montana State Champion.



TOMMY OWEN, Head Coach at Central Valley HS. Tommy was an NCAA Qualifier in 2004 and 2005 for the University of Minnesota. He placed 7th at the University Freestyle National in 2003, was a Junior National Freestyle Champion in 2002, and is a former 3 time Washington State champion and a 2001 National HS Champion.



TODD SLATER, Assistant Coach at East Valley H.S., placed second in the Washington State Tournament in 2000 and wrestled for two years at North Idaho College.



BRIAN OWEN, Boise State University, was a 2008 member of the Junior Pan-American Team. He placed second in freestyle competition at the AS-SIC Junior National Freestyle Championships in 2007. Owen is a former Cadet National Champion, a two-time Washington State Champion, and a NCAA tournament qualifier in 2009 for BSU.
