

Former ESU WR Tim Wilson Signs with Philadelphia Eagles

EAST STROUDSBURG - Former East Stroudsburg University wide receiver Tim Wilson has signed with the Philadelphia Eagles following the team's rookie minicamp, it was announced by the Eagles on Twitter on Monday morning.

Wilson, a graduate of Radnor High School, finished his ESU career with 133 catches for 2,042 yards and 16 touchdowns, an average of 15.4 yards per catch. He ranks 11th at ESU in career receptions and 13th in yards.

Wilson was named second team All-PSAC East in each of his last two seasons for the Warriors - 58 receptions, 910 yards and eight TD in 2016 and 53 receptions, 821 yards and four TD in 2017. He was seventh in the PSAC in both receptions (5.8 per game) and yards (91.0 per game) as a junior, and ninth in yards (74.6 ypg) and 11th in receptions (4.8 rpg) as a senior.

He ranks 10th at ESU in career all-purpose yards (3,105), with 909 kick return yards for a 21.6-yard average and 162 punt return yards for a 6.5-yard average, along with his 2,042 career receiving yards.
