

Noah Clary (Upper Sandusky, Ohio/Upper Sandusky H.S.) won the 174-pound weight class in his collegiate debut and **Ray Porter** (Strongsville, Ohio/Strongsville H.S.) earned a runner-up finish to lead Lourdes to a sixth place finish as a team at the Adrian Invitational on Saturday inside the Merillat Sport & Fitness Center in Adrian, Mich.

Clary began his day with a tech fall victory over Henry Ford 22-5 before registering another tech fall in the quarterfinals against Defiance 27-6. In the semifinals, the freshman earned his first college fall just 51 seconds into the match against Thiel before downing John Carroll in a 5-4 decision in the title bout.

Porter opened with a first round fall late in the second period against Wabash before winning via decision versus an opponent from John Carroll. In the junior's semifinal match, he earned a fall with 57 seconds remaining in the opening stanza against Wabash before falling in a 19-7 major decision in the title contest against John Carroll.

“This was a solid start to the season,” head coach **Dock Kelly III** said afterwards. “It was exciting to have two finalists along with three other top-eight placers. Noah Clary competed well all day long, and it was great to see him grind out a close win in the finals. Finishing in sixth place as a team shows that we had solid contributions from several weight classes, and that is something we can continue to build upon.”

Tyler Roberts (Hudson, Mich./Hudson H.S.) finished in fourth place at 133 pounds, winning a three matches by decision and another via major decision. **Isaac Ingram** (Lima, Ohio/Bath H.S.) posted a sixth place effort at 174 pounds, earning wins by fall, tech fall, and major decision. **Jake Bria** (Fairfield, Ohio/Fairfield H.S.) was an eighth place finisher for the Gray Wolves at 184 pounds, earning a win by fall and another by major decision.

Liam Alicardi (Westerville, Ohio/North H.S.) earned his first collegiate win at 133 pounds while **Tyler Gates** (Smiths Creek, Mich./Marysville H.S.) **Bobby Kelley** (Ney, Ohio/Fairview H.S.), and **Grant Pittroff** (Miamisburg, Ohio/Miamisburg H.S.) each posted a victory at 165 pounds. **Hunter Jacks** (Gallipolis, Ohio/Gallia Academy) won a match at 184 pounds while **Layton Mitchell** (Groveport, Ohio/Madison H.S.) picked up a victory at 285 pounds.

As a team Lourdes tallied 69 points, five more than Toledo. Adrian finished just ahead of the Gray Wolves with 84 points. Wabash claimed the team title with 170 points one

the day, forcing them to forfeit. Trachten claimed the team had won the points, one more than runner-up Mount Union.

“We have a short turnaround before our next match, so we will work to correct the areas of concern at practice on Monday,” Kelly concluded.

Lourdes begins its dual match schedule on Thursday evening, traveling to Ashland for a 7 p.m. contest inside of Kates Gymnasium in Ashland, Ohio.
