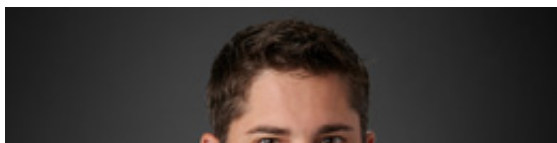

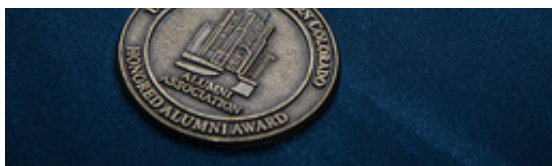




Bears Gain a New Voice
