OCU competes in WCWA Championships

MARIETTA, Ga. – Margaret Douma and Cassidy Jasperson from Oklahoma City University will wrestle to become three-time all-Americans, while the Stars' Daniela Flores will compete for her second all-American nod in the Women's College Wrestling Association Championships on Friday and Saturday at the Cobb Civic Center. Five Stars held spots in the most recent WCWA individual rankings. Oklahoma City enters the tournament at the ninth spot in the team ratings.

OCU took national titles in 2009, 2010, 2011 and 2012 and runner-up finishes in 2008, 2013, 2014 and 2016.

Fans can watch or follow the action on live results via Flo Wrestling. Competition starts 9 a.m. EST (8 a.m. CST) each day, while the championship finals will be 6 p.m. EST (5 p.m. CST) Saturday.

Douma holds the 10th spot in the 143-pound ratings. Douma, a senior from Napa, Calif., brings a 68-51 record with 39 falls in her OCU career. She posted a seventh-place finish in the 2017 WCWA Championships and a runner-up finish as a sophomore.

Jasperson holds the sixth spot in the 116-pound rankings. Jasperson, a senior from League City, Texas, has gone 11-5 with six pins this season and 66-29 with 43 pins in a Stars singlet. Jasperson has twice taken fourth in the WCWA Championships.

Flores collected a seventh-place showing at 130 pounds in last year's national tournament. Flores, a senior from El Paso, Texas, owns a 10-8 mark with four falls in 2018-19 and a 48-45 career record.

OCU's Raven Guidry, Brooke Logan and Nkechinyere Nwankwo also appeared in the individual rankings. Guidry, a sophomore from Lafayette, La., is the eighth-ranked wrestler at 109 pounds. Guidry takes a 10-7 mark with a team-best seven pins into the event.

Logan, a freshman from El Mirage, Ariz., holds the No. 8 spot at 143, while Nwankwo, a redshirt freshman from Rosenberg, Texas, garnered the sixth spot in the 191-pound rankings. Nwankwo has gone 8-4, pinned three foes and won the Missouri Valley Open 170-pound title this season.

Daishea Jaime, a senior from Pomona, Calif., captured the Oklahoma City Blue Chip/Cliff Keen Open at 130 pounds Dec. 1 at Abe Lemons Arena.
