Rutgers Claims Wrestler of the Week Honor

Scarlet Knights' Ashnault earns Wrestler of the Week plaudit after upsetting No. 1 Matthew Kolodzik of Princeton

Wrestler of the Week

Anthony Ashnault, Rutgers

149 pounds – Gr. – South Plainfield, N.J. – South Plainfield

- Went 2-0 on the weekend in Rutgers' meets against Nebraska and Princeton
- Opened the weekend with a 16-1 tech fall against Nebraska's Jordan Shearer
- Defeated No. 1 Matthew Kolodzik of Princeton by a 10-2 major decision, helping the Scarlet Knights secure their 23rd consecutive win over in-state rival Princeton
- Improved to 19-0 on the season, including four wins against top-10 opponents
- Leads the team with 68 dual points, winning 14 matches by bonus, including seven pins, four tech falls and three majors
- Earns his first career Wrestler of the Week award
