***Hillger, Gross to compete at Beat The Streets:*** Redshirt junior Trent Hillger and new Wisconsin Assistant Coach Seth Gross will compete in **Beat The Streets' 2020 Virtual Benefit** on **Thursday, September 17th**. Hillger, a two-time All-American is set to face 2020 Big Ten Champion and 2017 Junior World Champion, Gable Steveson. Gross, a 2018 National Champion is paired against 2018 World bronze medalist, Joe Colon. Matches will be live-streamed on [FloWrestling](#).

***Heaton, Gross Ranked:*** In FloWrestling's updated **2020 Domestic Rankings**, both Ronna Heaton (53kg) and Seth Gross (57kg) find themselves inside the Top-10 of their respected weight classes. Heaton, who placed 5th at the 2019 USA Wrestling Senior Nationals Women's Freestyle Tournament and qualified for the 2020 Olympic Trials, comes in ranked 6th. Gross, a 2019 Bill Farrell International Champion and 2020 Olympic Trials qualifier is ranked 4th.
