We're less than seven weeks away from the Beat the Streets New York Annual Benefit, Final X New York, on June 8 at The Hulu Theater at Madison Square Garden in New York.

This past week, three athletes accepted their bids to compete at Final X New York, which will determine the 2022 U.S. Senior World Teams in all three Olympic wrestling disciplines: men's and women's freestyle and Greco-Roman.

Jordan Burroughs (men's freestyle), Helen Maroulis (women's freestyle) and G'Angelo Hancock (Greco-Roman) each declared their spots. We're excited to welcome back Burroughs and Maroulis -- who have competed in the most matches in Benefit history -- and see Hancock make his Benefit debut this year.

For the next two weeks, BTS will announce the remaining 2020 Olympic and 2021 World medalists who will compete at Final X New York. The Final X opponent for each declared medalist will be determined at the World Team Trials Challenge Tournament, set for May 20-22 in Coralville, Iowa.
