We're less than five weeks out from the Beat the Streets New York Annual Benefit, Final X New York, on June 8 at The Hulu Theater at Madison Square Garden in New York.

This electrifying event helps Beat the Streets New York raise millions of dollars to support local youth wrestling programs which empower young people in New York City.

Four more athletes accepted their bids to compete at Final X New York, which will determine 15 spots on the 2022 U.S. Senior World Teams in all three Olympic wrestling disciplines: men's and women's freestyle and Greco-Roman.

Kyle Dake and David Taylor (men's freestyle), and Sarah Hildebrandt and Kayla Miracle (women's freestyle) each declared their spots. We're excited to welcome back Dake and Taylor -- who have previously competed in Benefit matches -- and see Hildebrandt and Miracle make their Benefit debuts.

The Benefit will feature seven 2020 Olympic and 2021 World medalists. Jordan Burroughs (men's freestyle), G'Angelo Hancock (Greco-Roman) and Helen Maroulis (women's freestyle) declared in early April. The Final X opponent for each declared medalist will be determined at the World Team Trials Challenge Tournament, set for May 20-22 in Coralville, Iowa.

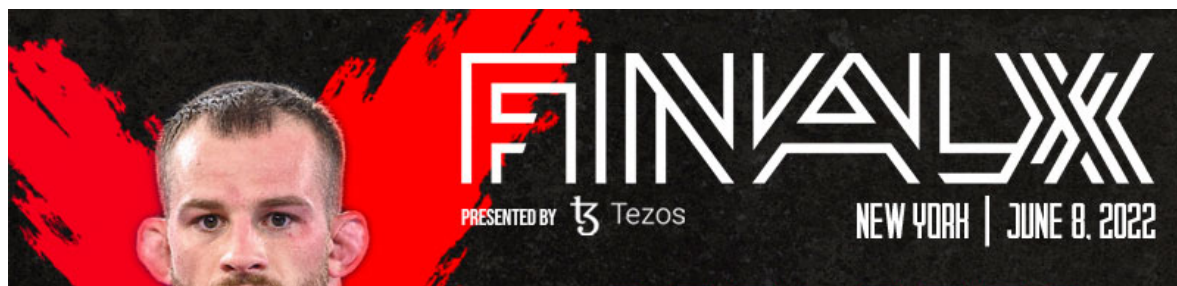
